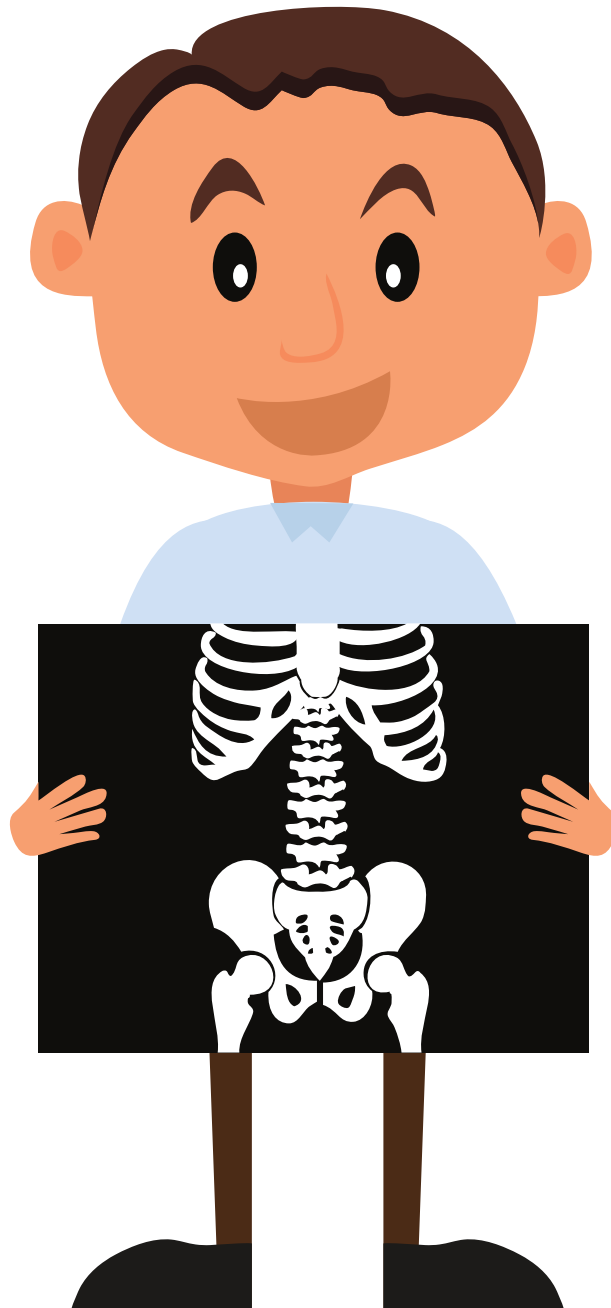

Human X-ray

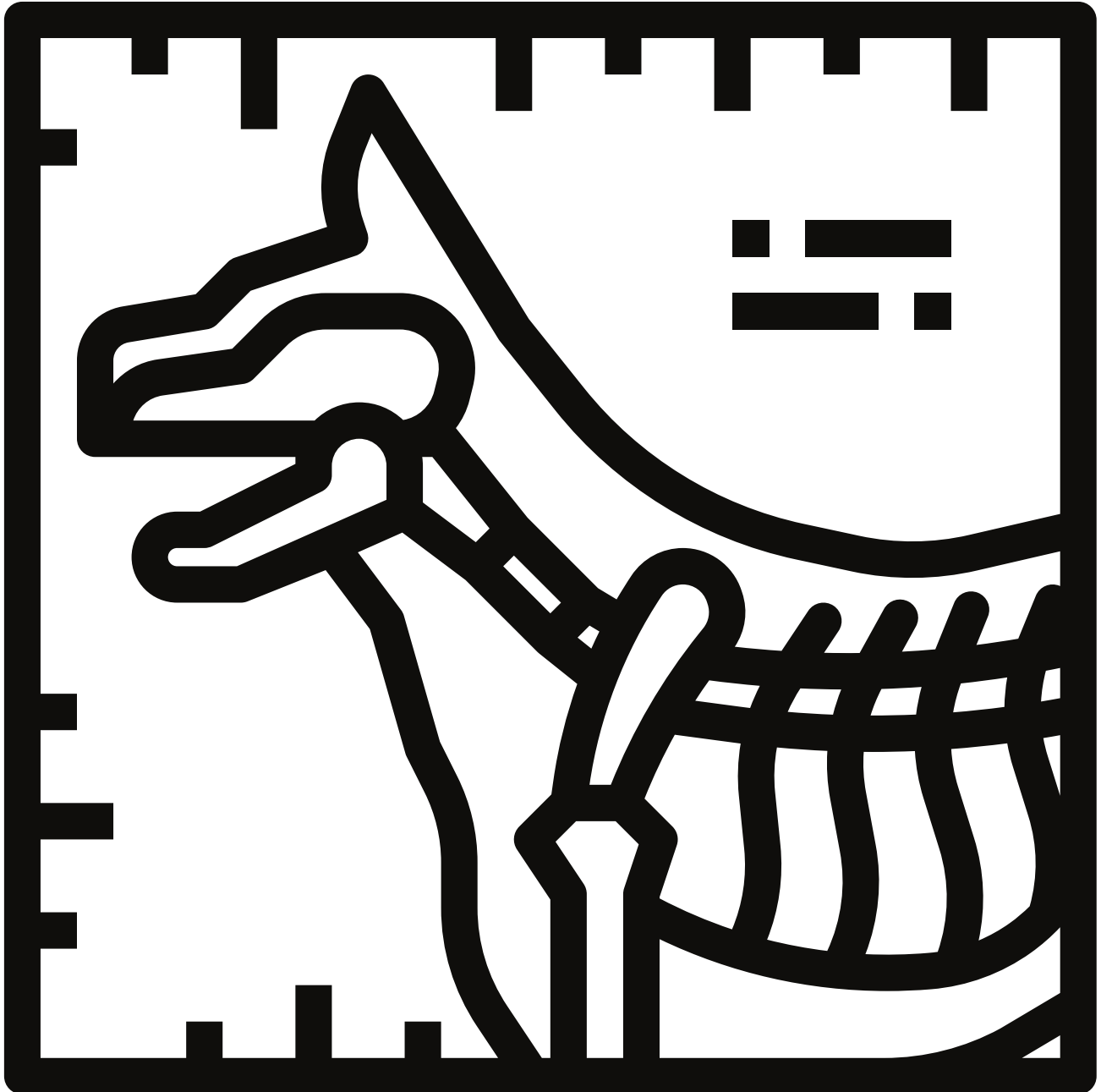


The human hand is made up of 27 bones. X-ray images allow specially trained doctors called radiologists to look inside of you and make sure everything is okay.

Dog X-ray

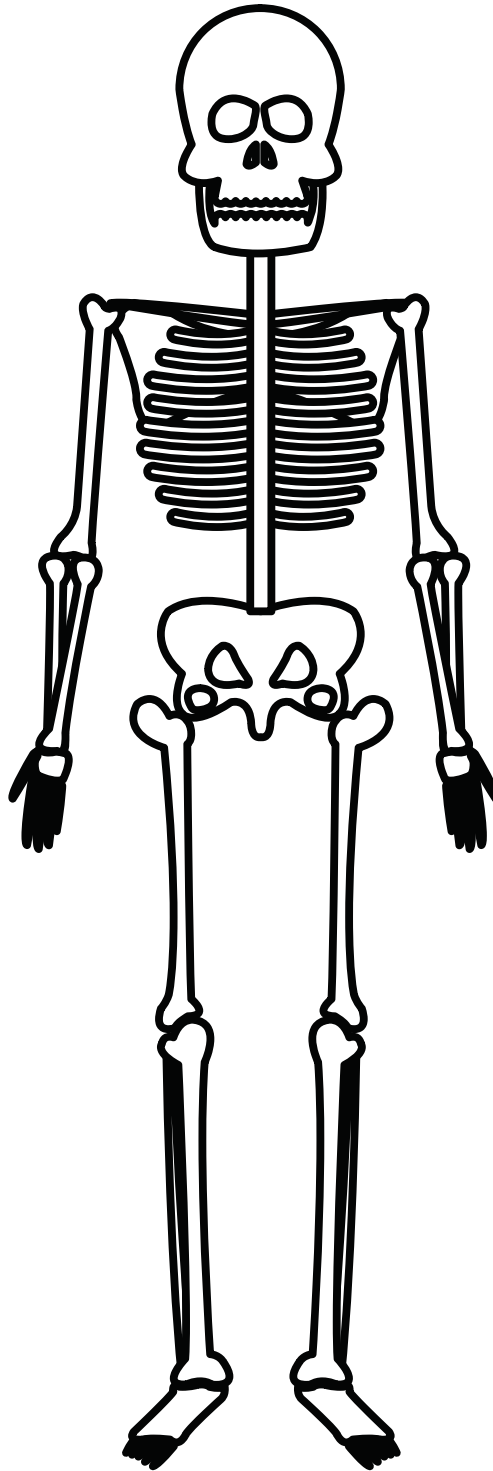


Dogs go to pet doctors called veterinarians for X-rays, but they take the same kinds of images people doctors do to look inside of them.

Skeleton

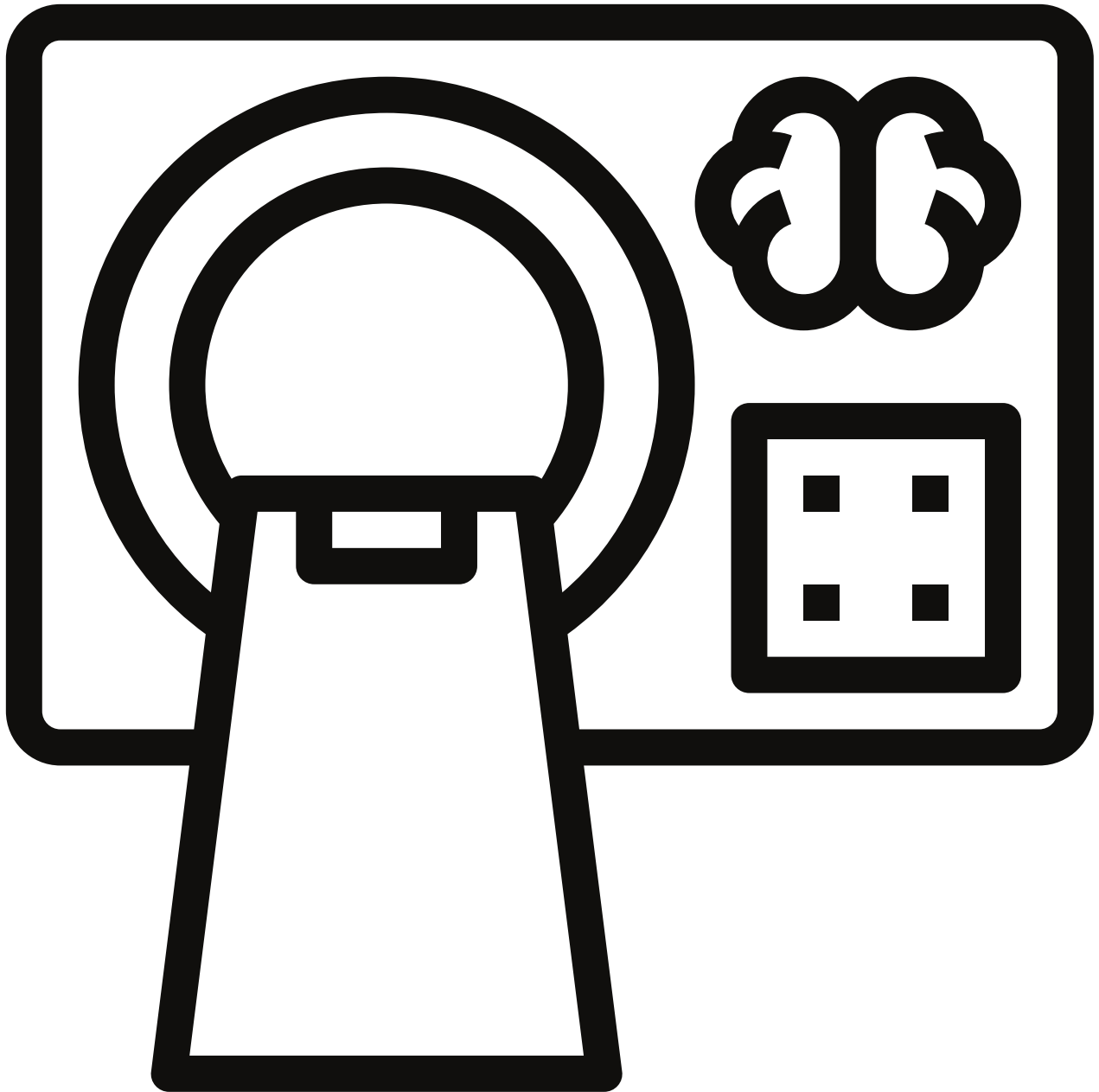


Your skeleton is made up of 206 bones. It gives you shape, support and protection.

MRI

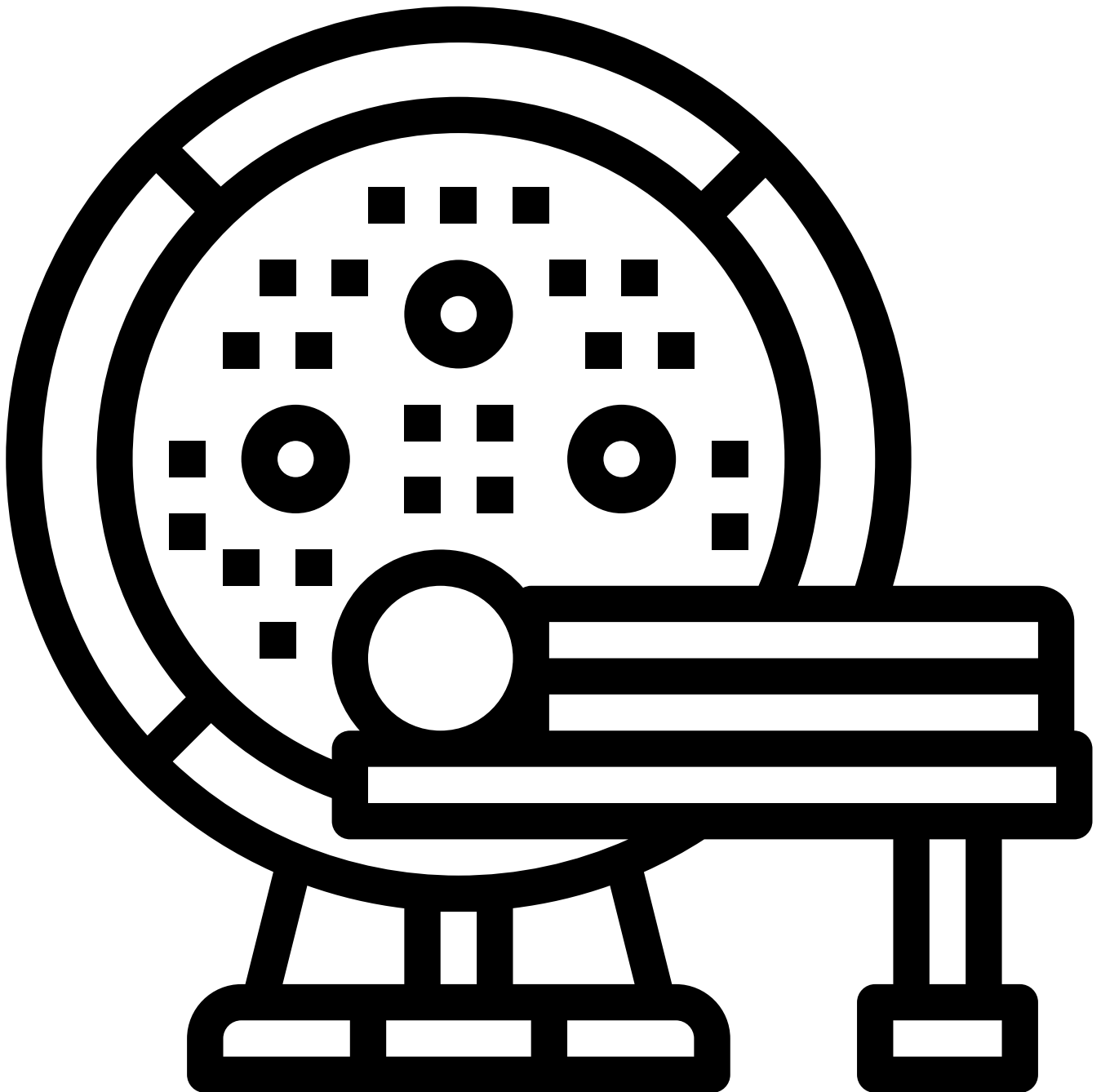


MRI is short for Magnetic Resonance Imaging. This machine uses strong magnets to take pictures of your body's internal organs.

CT

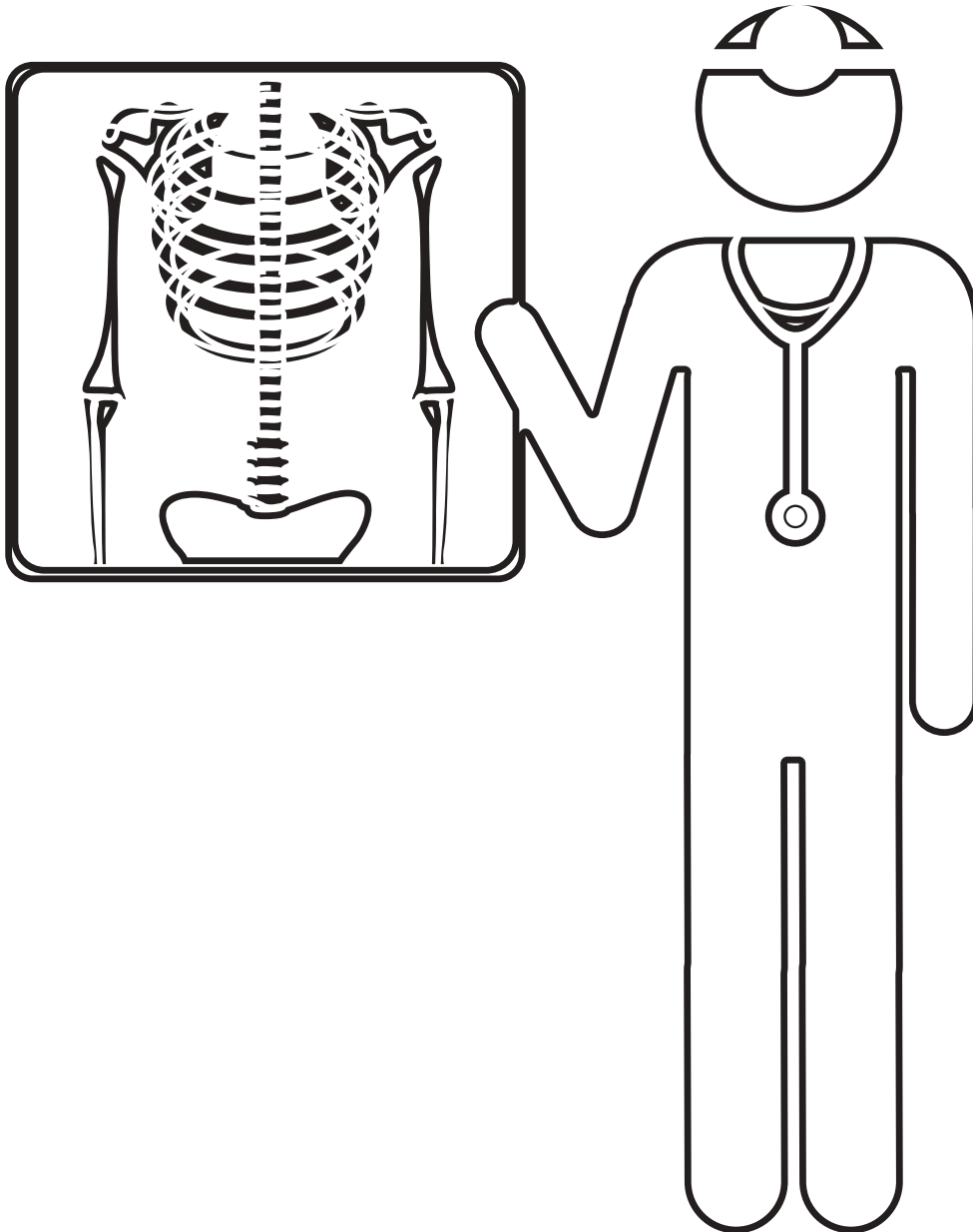


CT is short for Computed Tomography. This machine uses X-rays to create images of the inside of your body.

Radiologist

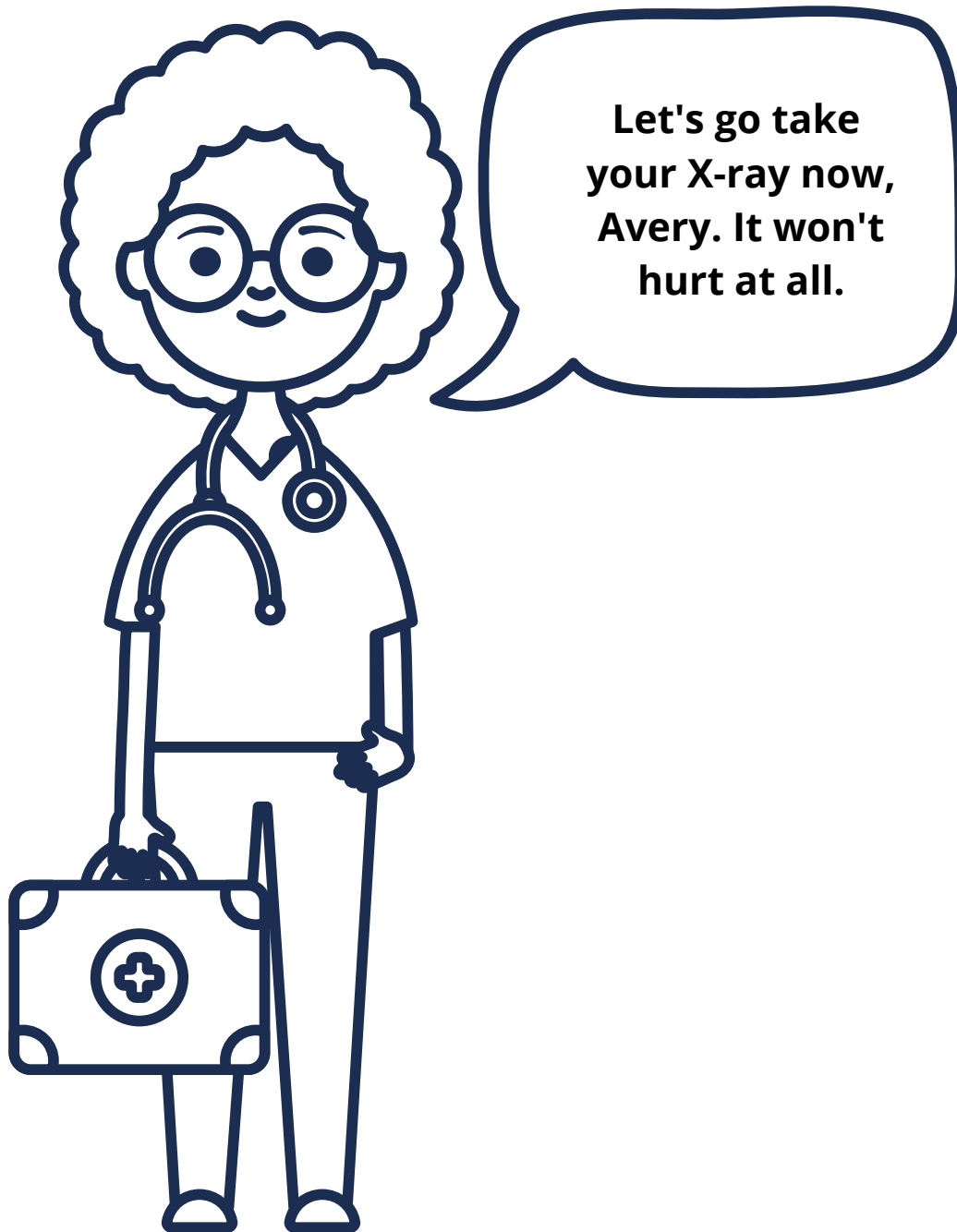


A radiologist is a doctor who treats patients using imaging such as X-rays, CTs and MRIs. Radiologists complete at least 13 years of training and often become specialists in areas such brains or hearts.

Technologist



A technologist helps the radiologist by performing the imaging tests. They work directly with patients to make sure they are always safe and comfortable.
