Dr. Robert C. Ward has been appointed Associate Chief of Diagnostic Imaging at Women & Infants Hospital. Dr. Ward will work alongside Dr. Susan Koelliker, Chief of Diagnostic Imaging, to further the academic and clinical missions of the department and the hospital.
